



## NHS muralist uses her talent to create wall art for young people

An artist who painted a giant mural to celebrate the NHS has now put the finishing touches to wall art to brighten the lives of young people.

Pat Cockerill, who works for our Trust's ADHD (Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder) team in Ipswich, has been painting murals for nearly 20 years. This has included designs at Walker Close and Ipswich Hospital.

She has now completed a 15ft oil-painted mural at the Level Two Youth Club in Felixstowe. The club, a lottery-funded charity which supports young people aged seven to 25, is based above Tesco's in Cobbold Road – hence the name 'Level Two'.

Pat, a Clinical Support Administrator, at the Children's Treatment Centre in Walker Close, said: "My connection came about through a recommendation from the manager of the local East of England Co-op. He heard that Level Two were looking for someone to paint a mural and the Co-op had some community funding to commission it.
